HERE COMES MONGO, away alertly, was well rated three wide prompting the pace outside NOT NECESSARILY, drew alongside after a half mile, spurted clear without much asking entering the lane, shifted in towards the rail leaving the quarter pole, drew out under some right handed rousing in mid stretch then was allowed to cruise home through the final seventy yards. DAPER'S DRINK, taken to rate off the rail while between runners past the five eighths, commence a run after a half mile, circled five wide into the stretch, briefly loomed but proved no match while well clear of the rest. WISE MEN broke slowly, rushed up inside leaving the chute and heading towards the three quarter pole, remained inside pursuing into the stretch and gave effort to the wire. GAME BREAK came in at the break bumping a rival and causing others to be in tight, corrected and pulled his way forward five wide outside foes, entertained the pace past the three quarter marker, dropped back a bit heading to the turn, remained wide chasing and faded through the drive. YES MEANS NO, jostled and put in close at the start, lagged off the early pace, raced four wide mid turn and failed to seriously recover. NOT NECESSARILY, a bit rank when leading leaving the chute, relaxed then handled outside pressure into the turn, ceded to the winner around the turn, pursued past the three sixteenths and

gave way. ABOVE IT ALL saved ground without threatening. SIR SMARTY lost any real chance when roughed up at the break. CREATIVE TIME, well placed in the clear early on, dropped back. OPTICAL ILLUSION was outrun. DITEN rushed up between foes early, briefly forced the pace and faltered.
